

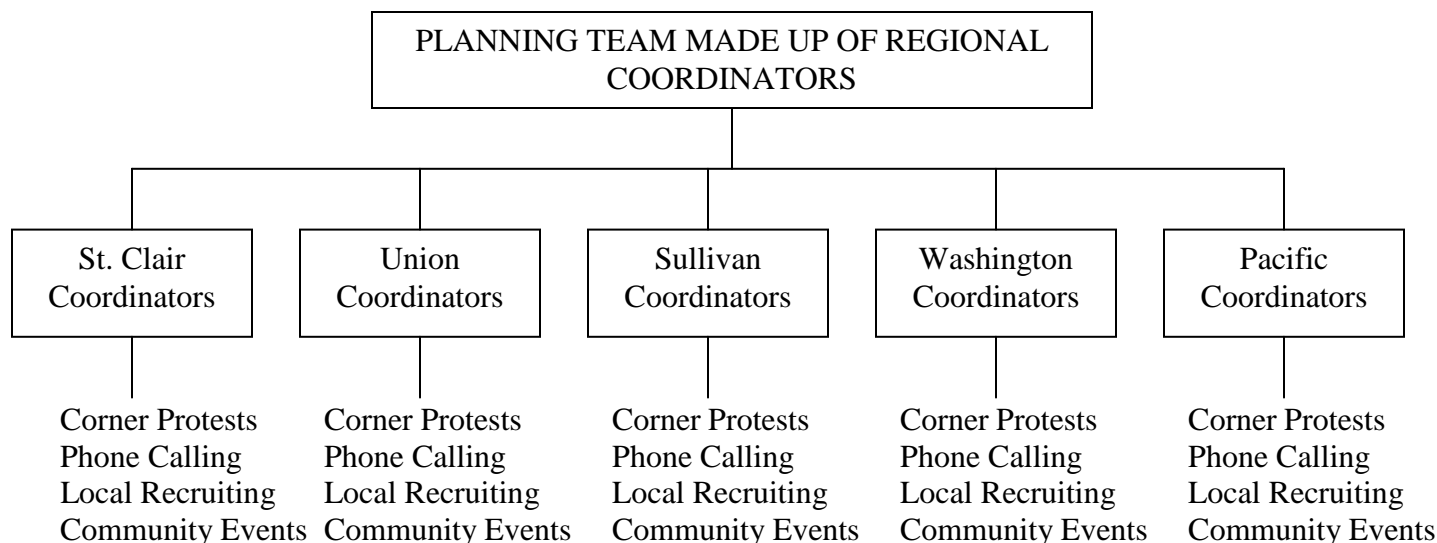
FRANKLIN COUNTY PATRIOTS COMMUNITY ORGANIZERS

Patriotic Opportunities and Job Descriptions

I. GROWING THE ORGANIZATION

In order for the Franklin County Patriots to further expand our network, improve our communications, and increase our influence, we must continue to coordinate our great team of organizers. One of our pressing needs is to develop and strengthen our group in the five regions of the county.

B. Regional Goals and Objectives

1. Enlisting new members
2. Organizing outreaches at community events (fairs, parades, etc.)
3. Contacting members (phone calls) for FCP events. We have more than 100 members thus far who do not use e-mail.
4. Developing lists of available places to meet, with costs, seating capacities, etc.
5. Organizing street corner protests
 - a. The more locations and the more participants we have, the better.
 - b. We would like to see our protests scheduled at different times of the week.
6. Investigating opportunities for community awareness and involvement; school board meetings, city council meetings, etc.
7. Localized training events (Constitutional lessons, teaching 5,000 year leap, etc.)
8. Coordinate the distribution of literature for events such as Tea Parties.
9. Door-to-door surveys

C. Dealing with Opposition

1. Be courteous and exercise self-control at all times.
2. We are not interested in being drawn into conflicts.
3. Our enemies are not individuals, but destructive and unconstitutional ideas.
4. Our most powerful weapon is not force, but truth.

D. Forming Other Patriot Organizations

1. Surrounding Counties
 - a. Members from these counties have expressed interest in seeing a similar grass roots organization formed (West St. Louis County, Warren County, Crawford County, Jefferson County).
 - b. Things to consider

- 1) Are there existing organizations that have similar goals?
 - 2) How much serious interest exists in the area?
 - 3) We are available and eager to help if and where needed.
2. We have received requests from three different states for assistance in forming organizations.

E. Volunteers Needed

1. Regional Coordinators
 - a. Ideally, we would like to see several Regional Coordinators in each area.
 - b. These individuals must be willing, and have the time, to help coordinate Franklin County Patriots activities in each region.
 - c. Regional coordinators will assist in planning the FCP calendar and events.

3. Telephoning FCP members about events.
4. Willing to attend city council meetings, school board meetings, etc.
5. Interested in assisting in forming additional Patriotic groups in nearby counties.
